*Federal regulations found in Title 49 of the Code of Federal Regulations (49 CFR) Part 172.702 require that each employer whose employees work with hazardous materials (as defined in sections 49 CFR 171 and 172) must train each of its hazmat employees. "Hazmat employees" include those who prepare the packages for shipping, prepare, sign or review the paperwork, load trucks, drive the vehicles or unload or receive the hazardous materials.*

## **DOT Required Training**

The terms "hazmat employee" and "hazmat employer" are defined in detail in 49 CFR 171.8. Stated briefly, a hazmat employee is anyone who directly affects hazardous materials transportation safety, and a hazmat employer is anyone who uses employees in connection with transporting hazardous materials in commerce, causing hazardous materials to be transported, or manufacturing or offering packaging's as authorized for use in transportation of hazardous materials.

### **DOT HM-126F Hazardous Material General Awareness: 49 CFR parts 171-180**

**This course is intended to educate any individual who prepares, handles, stores, transports, creates shipping papers, and/or is exposed in any capacity to hazardous materials of any kind. Individuals are provided with a General Awareness of hazardous materials regulations including an overview of the Hazardous Materials Regulations, identification and emergency preparedness. In addition, this course provides Function Specific and Safety training applicable to the products handled and safety measures in place at the site. This course also satisfies the training requirements of the OSHA Hazardous Communications Standard and EPA Right-to-Know. Participants are provided with a site-specific handbook covering in detail all information addressed during the course. Upon completion of the course, participants demonstrate understanding of the subject matter and obtain certification.**

### **DOT HAZMAT HM-181 & HM-215: 49 CFR Parts 172, 173 and 177)**

**This course covers the DOT requirements for the shipping and handling of hazardous materials. It also covers different shipping classes, packaging requirements, placarding, labeling, and the proper method of filling out a shipping manifest.**

### **DOT HM-232 Security Awareness (49 CFR §172.704(a)(4-5))**

**HM-232 was newly created by the DOT in March 2003 in response to the increased amount of security threats to the United States. The security awareness training again needs to be conducted within 90 days of a person being hired or starting a new job. If you have received Hazmat Employee Training within the last three years and your training did not address Security Awareness, then you are out of compliance with HM-232 and this course would bring you into compliance with the regulation.**

*If you need DOT Hazmat Employee training or you are seeking a three-year DOT refresher, then any of our other DOT courses would meet your needs and do include the HM-232 material. A certificate documenting compliance with the DOT requirement is presented upon completion.*
